ASCO QOPI™ Pilot

ASCO's Quality Oncology Practice Initiative (QOPI) pilot program allows practices in low- and middle-income countries to report on evidence-



based quality measures, receive individual performance scores, and participate in a limited measure set. Training will be provided virtually by English-speaking ASCO Care Delivery Registry staff, and participating institutions may gain access to the QOPI program, subject to legal review and compliance.
