## ASCO QOPI™ Pilot

ASCO's Quality Oncology Practice Initiative (QOPI) pilot program allows practices in low- and middle-income countries to report on evidence-based quality measures, receive individual performance scores, and participate in a limited measure set. Training will be provided virtually by English-speaking ASCO Care Delivery Registry staff, and participating institutions may gain access to the QOPI program, subject to legal review and compliance.



## Conquer Cancer® Grants & Awards

Conquer Cancer®, the ASCO Foundation, supports cancer research around the world, including programs geared toward oncologists in low- and middle-income countries. New funding opportunities added frequently; deadlines vary.



## Virtual Mentoring Program (VMP)

This year-long program pairs mentees with experienced professionals outside of their home institutions to help navigate career challenges and grow personally and professionally. Applications open in the fall of 2024.



## International Cancer Corps (ICC)\*

The ICC's mission is to improve the quality of cancer care at medical institutions in low- and middle-income countries by providing education and training to clinical staff. The Regional Council is in the process of selecting a site in Central and Eastern Europe.



## ESMO-ASCO Global Curriculum

The ESMO-ASCO Recommendations for a Global Curriculum in Medical Oncology are a set of common guidelines with a global perspective for clinical training required for physicians to qualify as medical oncologists. The Global Curriculum was developed by ASCO and the European Society of Medical Oncology (ESMO) with the goal of defining standards in guiding the training of medical oncologists worldwide and ensuring that all patients have an equal chance of receiving treatment from well-trained physicians.



## Leadership Development Program (LDP)

Through this immersive experience, participants gain leadership skills, mentoring, and invaluable insights into ASCO's roles and mission, witnessing firsthand the Society's influence in shaping the future of cancer care.
