


## Step-by-Step Guide - How to Renew ASCO Media Credentials

### Policies Agreement

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### Confidentiality Agreement

As a condition of ASCO providing access to confidential and embargoed information throughout the course of the year, an authorized representative of the news media outlet agrees, on behalf of the outlet and its reporters, producers, and others who may see the information, to comply with ASCO's confidentiality policy with respect to the abstracts, journal articles, and other embargoed information provided.

Reporters may not use information provided on an embargoed basis to:

- Make the information public, or provide it to others who may make it public.
- Publish the information, or provide it to others who may publish it.
- Use the information for trading in the securities of any issuer, or provide it to others who may use it for securities trading purposes.



Step 5: A member of ASCO’s Media Team will review your request for media credentials within three to five business days. As a reminder, no additional registration is needed in order to gain access to the embargoed meeting materials and/or meeting slides and presentations; you will receive access to all meeting information if your media credentials request is approved.

## Request to Renew Media Credentials Under Review

Thank you for renewing your ASCO media credentials. ASCO’s Media Team will review your information and update you on the status of your request within three to five business days. Since the 2021 ASCO Annual Meeting will be held online, no additional action is required to have access to the meeting presentations and slides. All journalists with approved ASCO media credentials will have access to the embargoed meeting information, embargoed abstracts, and meeting presentations and slides.
